


Fig.7 7. Remove all scrivets retaining bumper along inside edge of wheel arches (Fig.7).

18. Fit support mounting brackets (item 4,5) through the holes in frame to M12 nut plates (item 8), using bolts M12x30 (item E) and washers 12mm (item O). And use bolts M12x1,25x30 (item D) with penny washers 12mm (item P) to fix to factory mounting points in frame (Fig.18).

\*Do not tighten yet.




Fig.20 20. Fix winch bracket (item 3), using bolts M10x30 (item B) with washers 10mm (item N), nuts M10 (item K) and factory bolts (Fig.20). **\*Do not tighten yet.** 




Fig.21 21. Fix support mounting brackets (item 4,5) to 21 winch bracket, using M10 nut plates (item U), b bolts M10x20 (item A) and washers 10mm (item N) (Fig.21). \***Do not tighten yet.**




Fig.29 29. Remove the seal from the bumper. Pay attention to the slots in the brackets (Fig.29).




Fig.35 35. Connect the bumper body (item 1) and the end caps (item 32, 33), using inside bolts (item 34), nuts M10 (item K) and washers 10 (item N) (Fig.35). **\*Tighten hardware after that.**






Fig.38 38. Install countersunk washers (item S) in parking sensor holes on the bumper body (item1) (Fig.38).








Fig.46 46. Fix bumper body using: a - screws M10 (item H), countersunk washers (item T), washers 10 (item N), nuts M10 (item K); b - bolts M10 (item B), washers 10 (item N) and nuts M10 (item K). Align the bumper body with the vehicle. Tighten all the hardware (Fig.46).








Fig.51 51. Mark and drill 2 holes in plastic fenders according with holes in flaps. Attach flaps to plastic fenders, using screws M6x20 (item G) and washers 6mm (item L) (Fig.51).










Fig.71 68. Mark center line of grille (item 2) and badge (Fig.71).


